permits; and, in size, weight and load, further providing for permit for movement of bulk refined oil.

- 7 Section 1. Sections 1943(m) and 4979.1 of Title 75 of the
- Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended to read: 8
- § 1943. Annual hauling permits.
- * * * 10
- 11 Bulk refined oil and ethanol. -- The annual fee for
- 12 movement of bulk refined oil or ethanol, as provided for in
- 13 section 4979.1 (relating to permit for movement of bulk refined
- 14 oil and ethanol), shall be:
- 15 (1)\$1,130 for a distance up to 50 miles.
- 16 (2) \$1,690 for a distance of more than 50 miles up to
- 125 miles. 17

- § 4979.1. Permit for movement of bulk refined oil and ethanol.

- 1 An annual permit may be issued authorizing the movement on
- 2 specified highways of refined oil or ethanol in bulk between a
- 3 refinery and a distribution facility or an ethanol processing
- 4 <u>facility and distribution facility</u> which exceeds the maximum
- 5 vehicle gross weight specified in Subchapter C (relating to
- 6 maximum weights of vehicles). Permits issued under this section
- 7 shall not exceed a distance of 125 miles. The weight of any
- 8 vehicle permitted under this section may not exceed 107,000
- 9 pounds overall gross weight and shall have the following maximum
- 10 axle weight limits for all nonsteering axles:

11	Single axle	21,000 pounds
12	Tandem axles	42,000 pounds
13	Tridem axles	53,000 pounds
14	Quad axles	63,000 pounds

- 15 No permit may be issued for this type of movement upon an
- 16 interstate highway.
- 17 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
