7	Section 1. The definition of "military-overseas ballot" in

Duties and responsibilities of secretary. 17 \* \* \* 18 19 (c) Other duties. -- The secretary shall do all of the 20 following: 21 Establish an electronic transmission system through (1)2.2 which a covered voter may apply for and receive voter 23 registration materials, military-overseas ballots and other 24 information under this chapter. 25 Develop standardized absentee-voting materials and (2)26 their electronic equivalents, authentication materials and 27 voting instructions to be used with the military-overseas 28 ballot of a voter authorized to vote in any jurisdiction in 29 this Commonwealth. 30 To the extent reasonably possible, coordinate with (3)

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1 other states to carry out the provisions of this subsection. Prescribe the form and content of a declaration for 2 (4) 3 use by a covered voter who does not use the Federal write-in absentee ballot in accordance with the following: 4 5 The declaration shall require the covered voter (i) to swear or affirm, under penalty of perjury, specific 6 representations pertaining to the voter's: 7 8 (A) identity; 9 eligibility to vote; (B) 10 (C) status as a covered voter; and 11 timely and proper completion of a military-(D) 12 overseas ballot. 13 (ii) The declaration shall be based on the FWAB 14 declaration, as modified to be consistent with this 15 chapter. The secretary shall ensure that a form for the 16 (iii) 17 execution of the declaration, including an indication of 18 the date of execution of the declaration, is a prominent 19 part of all balloting materials for which the declaration 20 is required. 21 (5) Establish an electronic transmission system in which 22 a covered voter under this chapter may cast an electronic\_ 23 ballot. The electronic transmission system shall be 24 operational by January 1, 2017. 25 § 3505. Registering to vote. \* \* \* 26 27 (c) Electronic transmission system. -- The secretary shall 28 ensure that the electronic transmission system described in 29 section 3503(c) (relating to duties and responsibilities of secretary) is capable of accepting a Federal postcard 30

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application, military-overseas ballot and any other approved electronic registration application sent to the appropriate county election board. The voter may use the electronic transmission system or any other approved method to register to vote.
