7	Section 1. Section 5704(18) of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania
8	Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
9	§ 5704. Exceptions to prohibition of interception and
10	disclosure of communications.
11	It shall not be unlawful and no prior court approval shall be
12	required under this chapter for:
13	* * *
14	(18) A person to intercept oral communications for
15	disciplinary or security purposes on a school bus or school
16	vehicle, as those terms are defined in 75 Pa.C.S. § 102
17	(relating to definitions), if all of the following conditions
18	are met:
19	(i) The school board has adopted a policy that

authorizes audio interception on school buses or school
 vehicles for disciplinary or security purposes.

(ii) Each school year, the school board [notifies
students and their parents or guardians of the policy, by
letter mailed to the students' home addresses.] <u>includes</u>
<u>the policy in a student handbook and in any other</u>
<u>publication of the school entity that sets forth the</u>
<u>comprehensive rules, procedures and standards of conduct</u>
for the school entity.

10 (iii) The school board posts a notice that students 11 may be audiotaped, which notice is clearly visible on 12 each school bus or school vehicle that is furnished with 13 audio-recording equipment.
