## AN ACT

1 Designating the bridge carrying State Route 3087 over Jacobs  
2 Creek connecting Scottdale, Westmoreland County, and Everson,  
3 Fayette County, as the Private First Class Joseph Anthony  
4 Petrarca/Staff Sergeant John William Earnesty Memorial  
5 Bridge.

6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
7 hereby enacts as follows:

8 Section 1. Private First Class Joseph Anthony Petrarca/Staff  
9 Sergeant John William Earnesty Memorial Bridge.

10 (a) Findings.--The General Assembly finds and declares as  
11 follows:

12 (1) Private First Class (PFC) Joseph Anthony Petrarca  
13 was born on March 22, 1948, and was a 1968 graduate of  
14 Southmoreland High School.

15 (2) PFC Petrarca served in the 1st Cavalry Division, 1st  
16 Battalion, 7th Cavalry, Company E, and was killed in action  
17 on March 17, 1969, in South Vietnam, just five days before  
18 his birthday.

19 (3) PFC Petrarca was the only resident of Scottdale,  
20 Westmoreland County to lose his life in the Vietnam War.

1           (4) Staff Sergeant (S SGT) John William Earnesty was  
2 born on October 2, 1928, and was a veteran of World War II  
3 and the Korean War.

4           (5) S SGT Earnesty served in South Vietnam with the 25th  
5 Infantry Division, 1st Battalion, 5th Infantry, Company C.

6           (6) On December 11, 1966, S SGT Earnesty was killed in  
7 South Vietnam after the armored personnel carrier in which he  
8 was riding detonated a land mine.

9           (7) S SGT Earnesty was the only resident of Everson,  
10 Fayette County, to lose his life in the Vietnam War.

11          (b) Designation.--The bridge carrying State Route 3087 over  
12 Jacobs Creek connecting Scottdale, Westmoreland County, and  
13 Everson, Fayette County, is hereby designated the Private First  
14 Class Joseph Anthony Petrarca/Staff Sergeant John William  
15 Earnesty Memorial Bridge.

16          (c) Signs.--The Department of Transportation shall erect and  
17 maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the ~~road~~ <--  
18 BRIDGE to traffic in both directions ~~on~~ OF the ~~road~~ BRIDGE. <--  
19 Section 2. Effective date.

20          This act shall take effect in 60 days.
