## A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the Commonwealth
- of Pennsylvania, providing for failure to enact a general
- 3 appropriation bill.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby resolves as follows:
- 6 Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of
- 7 Pennsylvania is proposed in accordance with Article XI:
- 8 (1) That Article III be amended by adding a section to read:
- 9 § 13.1. Failure to enact a general appropriation bill.
- 10 (a) If a general appropriation bill is not signed into law
- 11 <u>within 90 days after the beginning of a fiscal year, all bills</u>
- 12 and resolutions pending in the General Assembly other than bills
- 13 <u>returned as a veto under section 15 of Article IV of this</u>
- 14 Constitution and the general appropriation bill, are void and
- 15 may no longer be considered. Members of the General Assembly may
- 16 reintroduce the voided bills and resolutions after the general
- 17 appropriation bill is signed into law.
- (b) Notwithstanding subsection (a), a bill or resolution may

- 1 <u>be introduced or reintroduced before the general appropriation</u>
- 2 bill is signed into law if three-fourths of the members of the
- 3 General Assembly determine, by an affirmative vote, that the
- 4 bill or resolution relates to a disaster emergency.
- 5 (c) As used in this section "disaster emergency" means those
- 6 conditions which may, by investigation, be found, actually or
- 7 <u>likely</u>, to:
- 8 <u>(1) affect seriously the safety, health or welfare of a</u>
- 9 <u>substantial number of citizens of this Commonwealth or</u>
- 10 preclude the operation or use of essential public facilities;
- 11 (2) be of such magnitude or severity as to require
- 12 essential State supplementation of county and local efforts
- or resources exerted or utilized in alleviating the danger,
- 14 <u>damage</u>, <u>suffering or hardship faced</u>; <u>and</u>
- 15 (3) have been caused by forces beyond the control of
- man, by reason of civil disorder or by riot or disturbance.
- 17 Section 2. (a) Upon the first passage by the General
- 18 Assembly of this proposed constitutional amendment, the
- 19 Secretary of the Commonwealth shall proceed immediately to
- 20 comply with the advertising requirements of section 1 of Article
- 21 XI of the Constitution of Pennsylvania and shall transmit the
- 22 required advertisements to two newspapers in every county in
- 23 which such newspapers are published in sufficient time after
- 24 passage of this proposed constitutional amendment.
- 25 (b) Upon the second passage by the General Assembly of this
- 26 proposed constitutional amendment, the Secretary of the
- 27 Commonwealth shall proceed immediately to comply with the
- 28 advertising requirements of section 1 of Article XI of the
- 29 Constitution of Pennsylvania and shall transmit the required
- 30 advertisements to two newspapers in every county in which such

- 1 newspapers are published in sufficient time after passage of
- 2 this proposed constitutional amendment. The Secretary of the
- 3 Commonwealth shall submit this proposed constitutional amendment
- 4 to the qualified electors of this Commonwealth at the first
- 5 primary, general or municipal election which meets the
- 6 requirements of and is in conformance with section 1 of Article
- 7 XI of the Constitution of Pennsylvania and which occurs at least
- 8 three months after the proposed constitutional amendment is
- 9 passed by the General Assembly.
