8	Section 1. Section 441.1 of the act of June 13, 1967
9	(P.L.31, No.21), known as the Human Services Code, is amended by
10	adding subsections to read:
11	Section 441.1. Persons Eligible for Medical Assistance* *

13	(c) Except as provided under subsection (a)(4) and (5), upon
14	notification of incarceration, the department shall temporarily
15	suspend, for a period of no more than two years, medical
16	assistance for a recipient who becomes incarcerated in a
17	correctional institution. The suspension of medical assistance
18	shall cease and the recipient shall continue to receive medical

1	assistance upon notification of an inmate's release from the
2	correctional institution, subject to the eligibility
3	requirements under the Commonwealth's approved Title XIX State
4	<u>Plan.</u>
5	(d) Notwithstanding subsection (c), upon notification from a
6	correctional institution of an inmate's release and submission
7	by the inmate of an application, the department shall determine
8	the inmate's eligibility for medical assistance. Except as
9	provided under subsection (a)(4) and (5), medical assistance may
10	not be provided until the date of the inmate's release.

11 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
