AN ACT

1 Amending the act of June 2, 1915 (P.L.736, No.338), entitled, as
2 reenacted and amended, "An act defining the liability of an
3 employer to pay damages for injuries received by an employe
4 in the course of employment; establishing an elective
5 schedule of compensation; providing procedure for the
6 determination of liability and compensation thereunder; and
7 prescribing penalties," in additional coverages, providing
8 for deemed employees of the Pennsylvania Game Commission.

9 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
10 hereby enacts as follows:

11 Section 1. Section 601 of the act of June 2, 1915 (P.L.736,
12 No.338), known as the Workers' Compensation Act, reenacted and
13 amended June 21, 1939 (P.L.520, No.281), is amended by adding a
14 subsection to read:

15 Section 601. * * *

16 (e) Whenever any member of a volunteer fire company,
17 volunteer fire department, volunteer ambulance corps or rescue
18 and lifesaving squad is injured in the performance of duties on
19 State game land, the member shall be deemed to be an employe of
20 the Pennsylvania Game Commission.

1 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
