21	(18) Any of the following:
22	(i) A transfer to a conservancy.
23	(ii) A transfer from a conservancy to the United States, the

Commonwealth or to any of their instrumentalities, agencies or
political subdivisions.

3 (iii) A transfer from a conservancy where the real estate is 4 encumbered by a perpetual agricultural conservation easement as 5 defined by the act of June 30, 1981 (P.L.128, No.43), known as 6 the "Agricultural Area Security Law," and such conservancy has 7 owned the real estate for at least two years immediately prior 8 to the transfer.

9 (iv) A transfer <u>occurring after November 30, 2014</u>, of an 10 agricultural conservation easement to or from the Commonwealth, 11 a county, a local government unit or a conservancy under 12 authority of the "Agricultural Area Security Law."

13 (v) A transfer of a conservation easement or preservation 14 easement under the act of June 22, 2001 (P.L.390, No.29), known 15 as the "Conservation and Preservation Easements Act."

(vi) A transfer of a perpetual historic preservation easement, a perpetual public trail easement or other perpetual public recreational use easement, a perpetual scenic preservation easement or a perpetual open-space preservation easement to or from the United States, the Commonwealth, a county, a local government unit or a conservancy.
