AN ACT

- Amending the act of May 3, 1933 (P.L.242, No.86), entitled, as amended, "An act to promote the public health and safety by 2 providing for examination, licensing and granting of permits 3 for those who desire to engage in the profession of 4 cosmetology; defining cosmetology, and regulating cosmetology 5 salons, schools, students, apprentices, teachers, managers, 6 manicurists and cosmetologists; conferring powers and duties 7 upon the Commissioner of Professional and Occupational 8 Affairs of the Department of State; providing for appeals to 9 certain courts by applicants and licensees; and providing 10 penalties," further providing for definitions and for 11 sanitary rules. 12 13 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 14 hereby enacts as follows: 15 Section 1. Section 1 of the act of May 3, 1933 (P.L.242, No.86), referred to as the Cosmetology Law, is amended by adding 16 a definition to read: 17 18 Section 1. Definitions .-- The following words and phrases 19 when used in this act shall have the meanings given to them in 20 this section unless the context clearly indicates otherwise: 21 22 "Salon" means a licensed facility, other than a school of
- 23 cosmetology, where cosmetology is practiced.

- 2 Section 2. Section 14 of the act, amended July 7, 2006
- 3 (P.L.704, No.99), is amended to read:
- 4 Section 14. Sanitary Rules. -- (a) The board shall prescribe
- 5 such sanitary rules as it may deem necessary, with particular
- 6 reference to the precautions necessary to be employed to prevent
- 7 the creating and spreading of infectious and contagious
- 8 diseases; and it shall be unlawful for the owner of any salon or
- 9 school of cosmetology to permit any person to sleep in or use
- 10 for residential purposes any room used wholly or in part as a
- 11 salon or school of cosmetology.
- 12 (b) A lavatory shall be accessible for use by clients and
- 13 employees within the building where a salon is located.
- 14 (c) If a salon is located in or is part of a home or other
- 15 <u>building containing living quarters</u>, the portion of the home or
- 16 other building where the salon is located shall not be used as
- 17 <u>living</u>, <u>dining</u> or <u>sleeping</u> <u>guarters</u>.
- 18 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
