- 5 contributions architects have made to the history, texture and
- 6 quality of life in Pennsylvania; and
- 7 WHEREAS, The American Institute of Architects Pennsylvania
- 8 (AIA PA), founded in 1909, is the Statewide component of the
- 9 American Institute of Architects (AIA); and
- 10 WHEREAS, The AIA PA has a Statewide membership of more than
- 11 2,700; and
- 12 WHEREAS, The beginning of an organized architectural
- 13 profession in this nation was signified by the founding of the
- 14 AIA 150 years ago; and
- 15 WHEREAS, Architects express the richness of our heritage and
- 16 the vitality of spirit through the vigilant stewardship of great
- 17 architectural and historical treasures; and

- 2 individuals in this Commonwealth by combining advances in
