A RESOLUTION

- 1 Designating the month of November 2015 as "Adoption Awareness Month" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, Every year, hundreds of children in Pennsylvania
- 4 find themselves in need of a home and a safe and nurturing
- 5 environment; and
- 6 WHEREAS, The family is the foundation of any society and
- 7 children need the permanent love, care and protection of a
- 8 family to grow into healthy and productive adults; and
- 9 WHEREAS, As of early 2015, there were 1,743 children in this
- 10 Commonwealth waiting to be adopted; and
- 11 WHEREAS, For children waiting to be adopted in this
- 12 Commonwealth, the average length of stay in care is more than
- 13 three years; and
- 14 WHEREAS, The average age of Pennsylvania's adopted children
- 15 is about six years of age, with research showing that for youth
- 16 over nine years of age, the likelihood of being adopted drops

- 1 significantly; and
- 2 WHEREAS, The collaboration of both public and private
- 3 adoption agencies should be recognized for their commitment to
- 4 the needs of children throughout this Commonwealth; therefore be
- 5 it
- 6 RESOLVED, That the Senate designate the month of November
- 7 2015 as "Adoption Awareness Month" in Pennsylvania.
