- 6 WHEREAS, With 993 undergraduate and graduate chapters in our
- 7 Commonwealth and throughout the United States, the United States
- 8 Virgin Islands, the Caribbean, Canada, Japan, Germany, Korea,
- 9 Africa and other nations, AKA has grown and flourished in the
- 10 pursuit of peace and improved quality of life for others since
- 11 its establishment in 1908 at Howard University in Washington,
- 12 DC, by founder Ethel Hedgeman; and
- 13 WHEREAS, AKA members have generously engaged their energies
- 14 in global advocacy and service projects to improve
- 15 socioeconomic, racial, political and environmental conditions as
- 16 AKA's functions have expanded through the decades; and
- WHEREAS, The 283,000 distinguished women who comprise the
