1 2 3	Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in registration of vehicles, further providing for special registration plates.

6	Section 1. Section 1341(c) of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
7	Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
8	§ 1341. Special registration plates.

10	(c) Organization registration platesUpon request by the
11	applicant, the department is authorized to issue organization
12	registration plates. Organization registration plates may be
13	issued for special groups or for special purposes and bear an
14	appropriate designation. Special groups may charge a fee for
15	authorization to request a registration plate bearing the name
16	of the group <u>or a portion of the group as desired by the</u>
17	organization. If the vehicle is licensed to a business that is

not a member of the special group, the department shall issue the plate as long as the business owner or officer making application is a member of that group. An organization registration plate may be used only on a passenger car or truck, with a registered gross weight of not more than 14,000 pounds, trailer, motorcycle or motor home.

7 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 120 days.
