## AN ACT

- Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in trade and commerce, prohibiting the 2 retail sale and distribution of novelty lighters; and 3 imposing a penalty. 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 5 hereby enacts as follows: 7 Section 1. Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated 8 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read: § 7332. Retail sale and distribution of novelty lighters 10 prohibited. (a) Offense defined. -- It shall be unlawful for any person to 11 12 sell at retail, offer for retail sale or distribute for retail 13 sale or promotion in this Commonwealth a novelty lighter. 14 (b) Grading. -- A person who violates subsection (a) commits a 15 summary offense.
- 16 (c) Exception. -- Nothing contained in this section may
- 17 prohibit the transportation of novelty lighters through this
- 18 <u>Commonwealth or the storage of novelty lighters in a warehouse</u>
- 19 or distribution center in this Commonwealth if the warehouse or

- 1 <u>distribution center is closed to the public for purposes of</u>
- 2 retail sales.
- 3 (d) Definition.--As used in this section the term "novelty
- 4 <u>lighter" means a mechanical or electrical device typically used</u>
- 5 for lighting cigarettes, cigars or pipes that is designed to
- 6 appear to be a toy, to feature a flashing light or to make
- 7 musical sounds. The term does not include:
- 8 (1) A lighter manufactured prior to January 1, 1980.
- 9 (2) A lighter incapable of being fueled or lacking a
- device necessary to produce combustion or a flame.
- 11 (3) Any mechanical or electrical device primarily used
- to ignite fuel for fireplaces or for charcoal or gas grills.
- 13 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
