9	§ 9728. Collection of restitution, reparation, fees, costs,
10	fines and penalties.
11	(a) General rule

13	(2) In accordance with section 9730.1 (relating to
14	collection of court costs, restitution and fines by private
15	collection agency), the collection of restitution,
16	reparation, fees, costs, fines and penalties under this
17	section may be referred to a private collection agency. <u>Any</u>
18	county that does not engage the services of a private
19	collection agency shall establish a collections enforcement

1	unit consistent with the provisions of paragraph (1) and
2	dedicated to carrying out the duties therein provided.
3	Statistical information relating to the amount of restitution
4	collected by the county probation department or any agent
5	designated by the county commissioners of the county with the
6	approval of the president judge of the county shall be made
7	available to the Pennsylvania Commission on Crime and
8	Delinquency on an annual basis. The statistical information
9	shall be sufficiently detailed so as to show compliance with
10	the requirements of this section, including subsection (g.1).

12	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
