AN ACT

- Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in registration of vehicles, providing for special
- pediatric cancer research registration plate, and
- establishing the Pediatric Cancer Research Fund.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 8 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- 9 § 1369.3. Pediatric cancer research registration plate.
- 10 (a) Plate. -- The department, in consultation with relevant
- 11 <u>stakeholders</u>, <u>shall design a special pediatric cancer research</u>
- 12 registration plate. Upon application of a person, accompanied by
- 13 <u>a fee of \$50, which shall be in addition to the annual</u>
- 14 registration fee, the department shall issue the plate for a
- 15 passenger car or truck with a registered gross weight of not
- 16 more than 14,000 pounds, or a motor home.
- 17 (b) Pediatric Cancer Research Fund. -- The Pediatric Cancer

- 1 Research Fund is established in the State Treasury. The fee
- 2 collected by the department under this section shall be
- 3 deposited in the fund. All money in the fund shall be allocated
- 4 annually to institutions in this Commonwealth that conduct
- 5 pediatric cancer research. The allocation of funds shall be
- 6 equal among all pediatric cancer research institutions.
- 7 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
