## AN ACT

11	(b) MembershipThe commission shall be comprised of not
12	more than 17 members as follows:

14	(6) Up to 12 members appointed by the Governor as
15	follows:
16	(i) One member shall have experience at the senior
17	level of the military, such as an active duty retired

<u>one-star, two-star,</u> three-star or four-star military officer, [and] shall be familiar with the operations represented by the installations and organizations stationed in this Commonwealth <u>and shall be a resident of</u> <u>this Commonwealth</u>. The member shall serve as chairperson in the absence of the chairperson elected by a majority of the members.

8 (ii) At least ten members shall be representatives 9 of the military installations or organizations stationed 10 in this Commonwealth and shall have knowledge of the 11 mission and operations of the installation or 12 organization that they represent.

(iii) One member shall be an expert in the field of economic development and shall be knowledgeable in the missions and operations of the military in their respective regions of this Commonwealth.
