8	hereby enacts as follows:
9	Section 1. Section 5 of the act of February 17, 1994
10	(P.L.73, No.7), known as the Contractor and Subcontractor
11	Payment Act, is amended by adding a subsection to read:
12	Section 5. Owner's payment obligations.

14	(e) Suspension of performanceIf payment is not received
15	by a contractor in accordance with this section, the contractor
16	shall have the right to suspend performance of any work, without
17	penalty, until payment is received in full. Any term in a
18	construction contract contrary to this subsection shall be
19	unenforceable. Suspension of performance may occur only if:
20	(1) payment has not been made to the contractor in

3 (2) the contractor has provided at least seven calendar
4 days' written notice of the contractor's intent to suspend

13 (a) Entitlement to payment.--Performance by a subcontractor 14 in accordance with the provisions of the <u>construction</u> contract 15 shall entitle the subcontractor to payment from the party with 16 whom the subcontractor has contracted.

18 (c) Time for payment.--When a subcontractor has performed in 19 accordance with the provisions of the construction contract, a 20 contractor shall pay to the subcontractor, and each 21 subcontractor shall in turn pay to the subcontractor's 22 subcontractors, the full or proportional amount received for 23 each such subcontractor's work and materials, based on work 24 completed or service provided under the subcontract, 14 days 25 after receipt of each progress or final payment or 14 days after receipt of the subcontractor's invoice, whichever is later. 26 27 Payment shall be made under this section unless it is being withheld under section 11. 28
