AN ACT

Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in registration of vehicles, further providing for surrender of registration plates and cards upon suspension or 3 revocation and providing for suspension of registration for 4 failure to respond to citation; and, in fees, further providing for reinstatement of operating privilege or vehicle 6 7 registration. 8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. Section 1376(b.1) of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania 10 Consolidated Statutes, amended November 4, 2016 (P.L.1277, 11 12 No.165), is amended to read: 13 Surrender of registration plates and cards upon 14 suspension or revocation. 15 * * * Immediate seizure of registration plates and cards .--16 The department may delegate authority to the persons described 17 18 in this section to immediately seize registration plates and 19 cards upon imposition of the following: 20 a suspension imposed pursuant to section 1374(d)(3)

- or (4) (relating to suspension or revocation of vehicle
- 2 business registration plates) until all fees, taxes and
- 3 penalties have been paid;
- 4 (2) a suspension or revocation imposed pursuant to
- 5 section 1373(b)(3) (relating to suspension of registration)
- 6 or 1374(q);
- 7 (3) a suspension or revocation is reinstated after
- 8 determination of a matter as provided in section 1377
- 9 (relating to judicial review);
- 10 (4) a suspension imposed pursuant to section 1379
- 11 (relating to suspension of registration upon sixth unpaid
- 12 parking violation in cities of the first class) until all
- fines, penalties and costs have been paid; [or]
- 14 (5) a suspension imposed pursuant to section 1380
- 15 (relating to suspension of registration upon unpaid tolls)
- until all tolls, administrative fees and costs have been
- 17 paid, dismissed, reversed on appeal or canceled or if the
- owner or registrant enters into an agreement with the tolling
- entity to make installment payments[.]; or
- 20 (6) a suspension imposed pursuant to section 1381
- 21 <u>(relating to suspension of registration for failure to</u>
- 22 respond to citation).

- 24 Section 2. Title 75 is amended by adding a section to read:
- 25 § 1381. Suspension of registration for failure to respond to
- 26 citation.
- 27 <u>(a) Suspension of registration.--The department shall</u>
- 28 suspend the registration of a vehicle upon the notification from
- 29 an issuing authority or a court that the owner or registrant of
- 30 the vehicle has failed to respond to a citation or summons to

- 1 appear before an issuing authority or a court of competent
- 2 jurisdiction of this Commonwealth for any violation of this
- 3 title, other than parking, or who has failed to pay or defaulted
- 4 in the payment of any fine, costs or restitution imposed by an
- 5 <u>issuing authority or such courts for violation of this title.</u>
- 6 (b) Notice. -- At least 15 days before an issuing authority or
- 7 <u>a court notifies the department to impose a suspension under</u>
- 8 <u>subsection</u> (a), the issuing authority or court shall provide the
- 9 <u>owner or registrant written notice of the requirement to respond</u>
- 10 to the citation and pay all fines, restitution and penalties
- 11 <u>imposed by the issuing authority or court.</u>
- 12 (c) Period of suspension. -- A suspension under subsection (a)
- 13 shall continue until the department receives notice from the
- 14 <u>issuing authority or court that the owner or registrant</u>
- 15 <u>responded to the citation and paid all fines, restitution and</u>
- 16 penalties imposed or entered into an agreement with the issuing
- 17 authority or court to make installment payments for the fines,
- 18 restitution and penalties imposed. The suspension may be
- 19 reimposed by the department if the defendant fails to make
- 20 regular installment payments and, if applicable, pays the fee
- 21 prescribed in section 1960 (relating to reinstatement of
- 22 operating privilege or vehicle registration).
- 23 (d) Violations outside Commonwealth.--
- 24 (1) The department shall suspend the registration of a
- 25 <u>vehicle of any owner or registrant who has failed to respond</u>
- to a citation to appear before a court of competent
- 27 jurisdiction of the United States or any state that has
- 28 entered into an enforcement agreement with the department, as
- 29 authorized under section 6146 (relating to enforcement
- agreements), for any violation of the motor vehicle laws of

- 1 <u>such state, other than parking, or who has failed to pay any</u>
- 2 <u>fine or costs imposed by such court upon being duly notified</u>
- in accordance with the laws of such jurisdiction in which the
- 4 <u>violation occurred.</u>
- 5 (2) An owner or registrant who provides proof
- 6 satisfactory to the department that the full amount of the
- 7 <u>fine and costs has been forwarded to and received by the</u>
- 8 other state shall not be regarded as having failed to pay for
- 9 <u>the purposes of this subsection.</u>
- 10 (e) Admissibility of documents. -- A copy of a document issued
- 11 by an issuing authority or a court of this Commonwealth or by an
- 12 official of another state shall be admissible for the purpose of
- 13 proving a violation of this section.
- 14 Section 3. Section 1960 of Title 75, amended November 4,
- 15 2016 (P.L.1277, No.165), is amended to read:
- 16 § 1960. Reinstatement of operating privilege or vehicle
- 17 registration.
- The department shall charge a fee of \$70 or, if section 1379
- 19 (relating to suspension of registration upon sixth unpaid
- 20 parking violation in cities of the first class), 1380 (relating
- 21 to suspension of registration upon unpaid tolls), 1381 (relating
- 22 to suspension of registration for failure to respond to
- 23 <u>citation</u>) or 1786(d) (relating to required financial
- 24 responsibility) applies, a fee of \$88 to restore a person's
- 25 operating privilege or the registration of a vehicle following a
- 26 suspension or revocation.
- 27 Section 4. This act shall take effect in 180 days.
