## A JOINT RESOLUTION

- Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, further providing for exemptions and special
- 3 provisions.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby resolves as follows:
- 6 Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of
- 7 Pennsylvania is proposed in accordance with Article XI:
- 8 That section 2(c) of Article VIII be amended to read:
- 9 § 2. Exemptions and special provisions.
- 10 \* \* \*
- 11 (c) Citizens and residents of this Commonwealth[, who served
- 12 in any war or armed conflict in which the United States was
- 13 engaged and were honorably discharged or released under
- 14 honorable circumstances from active service,] who served in the
- 15 <u>United States Armed Forces</u>, including a reserve component or
- 16 National Guard, and were discharged or released from service
- 17 <u>under conditions other than dishonorable</u> shall be exempt from
- 18 the payment of all real property taxes upon the residence

- 1 occupied by the said citizens and residents of this Commonwealth
- 2 imposed by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania or any of its
- 3 political subdivisions if, as a result of military service, they
- 4 are blind, paraplegic or double or quadruple amputees or have a
- 5 service-connected disability declared by the United States
- 6 Veterans Administration or its successor [to be a total or 100%
- 7 permanent disability, and if the State Veterans' Commission
- 8 determines that such persons are in need of the tax exemptions
- 9 granted herein]. This exemption shall be [extended to the
- 10 unmarried surviving spouse upon the death of an eligible veteran
- 11 provided that the State Veterans' Commission determines that
- 12 such person is in need of the exemption] granted for the
- 13 <u>lifetime of such persons regardless of income</u>.
- 14 Section 2. (a) Upon the first passage by the General
- 15 Assembly of this proposed constitutional amendment, the
- 16 Secretary of the Commonwealth shall proceed immediately to
- 17 comply with the advertising requirements of section 1 of Article
- 18 XI of the Constitution of Pennsylvania and shall transmit the
- 19 required advertisements to two newspapers in every county in
- 20 which such newspapers are published in sufficient time after
- 21 passage of this proposed constitutional amendment.
- 22 (b) Upon the second passage by the General Assembly of this
- 23 proposed constitutional amendment, the Secretary of the
- 24 Commonwealth shall proceed immediately to comply with the
- 25 advertising requirements of section 1 of Article XI of the
- 26 Constitution of Pennsylvania and shall transmit the required
- 27 advertisements to two newspapers in every county in which such
- 28 newspapers are published in sufficient time after passage of
- 29 this proposed constitutional amendment. The Secretary of the
- 30 Commonwealth shall submit this proposed constitutional amendment

- 1 to the qualified electors of this Commonwealth at the first
- 2 primary, general or municipal election which meets the
- 3 requirements of and is in conformance with section 1 of Article
- 4 XI of the Constitution of Pennsylvania and which occurs at least
- 5 three months after the proposed constitutional amendment is
- 6 passed by the General Assembly.
