AN ACT

Amending the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), entitled "An act providing for and reorganizing the conduct of the 2 executive and administrative work of the Commonwealth by the 3 Executive Department thereof and the administrative 4 departments, boards, commissions, and officers thereof, 5 including the boards of trustees of State Normal Schools, or 6 7 Teachers Colleges; abolishing, creating, reorganizing or authorizing the reorganization of certain administrative 8 departments, boards, and commissions; defining the powers and 9 duties of the Governor and other executive and administrative 10 11 officers, and of the several administrative departments, boards, commissions, and officers; fixing the salaries of the 12 Governor, Lieutenant Governor, and certain other executive 13 and administrative officers; providing for the appointment of 14 certain administrative officers, and of all deputies and 15 other assistants and employes in certain departments, boards, 16 and commissions; providing for the regulation of pari-mutuel 17 thoroughbred horse racing and harness horse racing 18 activities, imposing certain taxes and providing for the 19 disposition of funds from pari-mutuel tickets; and 20 21 prescribing the manner in which the number and compensation of the deputies and all other assistants and employes of 22 certain departments, boards and commissions shall be 23 determined," in Commonwealth agency fees, further providing 24 25 for Department of State. 26 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 27 hereby enacts as follows: 28 Section 1. Section 618-A(1) of the act of April 9, 1929 29 (P.L.177, No.175), known as The Administrative Code of 1929, is

amended by adding subparagraphs to read:

23	Section 2. Within 30 days of the effective date of this
24	section, the Department of State shall make available and
25	publish in the Pennsylvania Bulletin a uniform form to request
26	the legalization of documents. The form shall include all of the
27	following:
28	(1) Name of requester.
29	(2) Organization.
30	(3) Address.

- 1 (4) Telephone number.
- 2 (5) Country for which documents are being prepared.
- 3 (6) Number of documents to be certified.
- 4 (7) Purpose of request.
- 5 (8) Signature of requester.
- 6 Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
