## AN ACT

- Amending Title 23 (Domestic Relations) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in marriage license, further providing
- for restrictions on issuance of license.

- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 1304(b) of Title 23 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 8 § 1304. Restrictions on issuance of license.
- 9 (b) Minors.--
- 10 (1) No marriage license may be issued if either of the
  11 applicants for a license is under [16] 18 years of age
  12 [unless the court decides that it is to the best interest of
- the applicant and authorizes the issuance of the license.
- 14 (2) No marriage license may be issued if either of the
- applicants is under 18 years of age unless the consent of the
- 16 custodial parent or guardian of the applicant is personally
- given before the person issuing the license or is certified
- 18 under the hand of the custodial parent or guardian attested

- 1 by two adult witnesses and, in the latter case, the signature
- of the custodial parent or guardian is acknowledged before an
- 3 officer authorized by law to take acknowledgments. When the
- 4 minor has no guardian and a judge of the court is absent or
- 5 not accessible for any reason, the office issuing the license
- 6 may appoint a guardian pro hac vice for the minor].

- 8 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
