9	Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known

15	Section 2001-H. Scope of article.
16	This article relates to college and university suicide
17	prevention.
18	Section 2002-H. Definitions.
19	The following words and phrases when used in this article

- 1 shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 2 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 3 "Department." The Department of Education of the
- 4 Commonwealth.
- 5 <u>"Independent institution of higher education." As defined in</u>
- 6 section 302 of the act of November 29, 2004 (P.L.1383, No.180),
- 7 known as the Uniform Crime Reporting Act.
- 8 "Institution of higher education." An independent
- 9 <u>institution of higher education</u>, a community college, a State-
- 10 related institution or a member institution of the State System
- 11 of Higher Education.
- 12 <u>"Private licensed school." As defined in section 2 of the</u>
- 13 <u>act of December 15, 1986 (P.L.1585, No.174), known as the</u>
- 14 Private Licensed Schools Act.
- 15 <u>"Student." A person who is enrolled on a full-time basis at</u>
- 16 <u>an institution of higher education or private licensed school.</u>
- 17 <u>"Suicide prevention program." A suicide prevention program</u>
- 18 <u>under this article.</u>
- 19 <u>Section 2003-H. Suicide prevention program.</u>
- 20 (a) Establishment.--Each institution of higher education and
- 21 private licensed school shall establish a suicide prevention
- 22 program.
- 23 (b) Professionals.--An institution of higher education or
- 24 private licensed school shall hire or contract with mental
- 25 health professionals who have training and experience with
- 26 suicide prevention. The professionals shall work with faculty
- 27 and staff on ways to recognize the warning signs and risk
- 28 factors associated with student suicide.
- 29 <u>(c) Access to professionals.--A professional under</u>
- 30 <u>subsection</u> (b) <u>shall be made available to students at the</u>

- 1 institution of higher education or private licensed school 24
- 2 hours a day, 7 days a week.
- 3 (d) Notice to students.--An institution of higher education
- 4 <u>or private licensed school shall transmit to each student the</u>
- 5 contact information of the professionals under subsection (b) no
- 6 <u>later than 15 days after the beginning of each semester or after</u>
- 7 any change in professionals or contact information.
- 8 Section 2004-H. Duties of department.
- 9 The department shall:
- 10 (1) Ensure compliance with this article.
- 11 (2) Solicit the cooperation of other agencies,
- institutions and organizations, both public and private, in
- carrying out the provisions of this article.
- 14 (3) Otherwise administer the provisions of this article.
- 15 <u>Section 2005-H. Report.</u>
- An institution of higher education and a private licensed
- 17 <u>school shall report to the department on the implementation of</u>
- 18 the suicide prevention program by the institution or school.
- 19 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
