AN ACT

Amending the act of June 29, 1953 (P.L.304, No.66), entitled "An act providing for the administration of a statewide system of 2 vital statistics; prescribing the functions of the State 3 Department of Health, the State Advisory Health Board and local registrars; imposing duties upon coroners, 5 prothonotaries, clerks of orphans' court, physicians, 6 7 midwives and other persons; requiring reports and certificates for the registration of vital statistics; 8 regulating the disposition of dead bodies; limiting the 9 10 disclosure of records; prescribing the sufficiency of vital statistics records as evidence; prescribing fees and 11 penalties; and revising and consolidating the laws relating thereto," in registration district administration, further 12 13 providing for local registrars' compensation. 14 15 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 16 hereby enacts as follows: 17 Section 1. Section 304(c) of the act of June 29, 1953 18 (P.L.304, No.66), known as the Vital Statistics Law of 1953, is amended to read: 19 20 Section 304. Registration Districts: Local Registrars' 21 Compensation. -- * * * 22 (1) A local registrar may not be compensated in excess (C) of [sixty thousand dollars (\$60,000)] eighty-five thousand 23 <u>dollars (\$85,000)</u> in any one calendar year. Compensation shall 24

- 1 include fees received from the department under subsection (a)
- 2 and retained from requesters under subsection (b).
- 3 (2) Upon reaching the limitation on compensation set forth
- 4 under clause (1) in any one calendar year, the local registrar
- 5 shall transmit all additional fees received under subsection (b)
- 6 to the department for deposit as follows:
- 7 (i) Three dollars (\$3) shall be deposited in the Vital
- 8 Statistics Improvement Fund.
- 9 (ii) Three dollars (\$3) shall be deposited in the General
- 10 Fund.

- 12 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
