AN ACT

- Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain 1 2 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial 3 schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," in certification of teachers, 5 providing for a cultural awareness continuing professional 6 development course. The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania

- hereby enacts as follows:
- Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known 10
- as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a 11
- 12 section to read:
- 13 Section 1218. Cultural Awareness Continuing Professional
- 14 Development Course. -- (a) The Department of Education shall
- develop and implement a continuing professional education course 15
- 16 on cultural awareness that may be used by professional educators
- 17 to satisfy the requirements of section 1205.2.
- 18 (b) The Department of Education shall develop the continuing
- 19 professional education course in a manner which provides
- professional educators with information and strategies which can 20

- 1 be incorporated into instruction and general interactions with
- 2 <u>students in order to encourage students to become more</u>
- 3 <u>culturally aware.</u>
- 4 (c) The continuing professional education course shall
- 5 <u>include training on the following:</u>
- 6 (1) Information and strategies to encourage students to
- 7 become more culturally aware, and to reject ethnic, cultural and
- 8 religious biases.
- 9 (2) Resolving disputes between students that result from
- 10 <u>ethnic and cultural disputes.</u>
- 11 (3) Resolving disputes between students that result from
- 12 <u>religious biases.</u>
- 13 (4) The dynamics of prejudice and discrimination that impede
- 14 <u>effective learning.</u>
- 15 <u>(5) Civil rights awareness.</u>
- 16 (d) Continuing professional education course materials may
- 17 include the following:
- 18 (1) Materials that educate students in cultural sensitivity
- 19 by introducing the students to various cultures.
- 20 (2) Teaching aids that allow students to explore cultures
- 21 through food, art, books, movies, dance, traditions and cross-
- 22 <u>cultural experiences</u>.
- 23 (3) Resources that allow students to explore the cultural
- 24 experience of other people, their history, present day
- 25 <u>experiences and connection to the American culture and fabric of</u>
- 26 our land.
- 27 (4) Educational aids that provide students with information
- 28 on the cultural experiences of the inhabitants of this
- 29 <u>Commonwealth</u>, the inhabitant's experience arriving in this
- 30 Commonwealth and development over the years.

- 1 (e) By July 31, 2018, and each July 31 thereafter, the
- 2 Department of Education shall submit to the chairman and
- 3 minority chairman of the Education Committee of the Senate and
- 4 the chairman and minority chairman of the Education Committee of
- 5 the House of Representatives a report which shall include:
- 6 (1) The number of professional educators that have enrolled
- 7 <u>in the continuing professional education course.</u>
- 8 (2) The number of professional educators that have completed
- 9 <u>the continuing education course.</u>
- 10 (3) The number of schools that have implemented classroom
- 11 <u>instruction in cultural awareness.</u>
- 12 (4) Any issues that professional educators, administrators,
- 13 <u>students or the Department of Education have identified and need</u>
- 14 to be addressed.
- 15 (f) The course established under subsection (a) shall be
- 16 <u>voluntary</u>, <u>offered online and at no cost to professional</u>
- 17 educators.
- 18 (g) For the purpose of this section, the term "professional"
- 19 educator" shall mean an individual who holds a Pennsylvania
- 20 teacher, educational specialist or administrative certification
- 21 or letter of eligibility.
- 22 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
