15	(c) The Board may admit to examination any person who has
16	satisfactorily completed a nursing education program for the
17	preparation of registered professional nurses or an approved
18	dietetics-nutrition education program in a country or territory
19	not mentioned above [who has been licensed, registered, or duly
20	recognized there as a professional nurse, dietitian-

nutritionist, dietitian or nutritionist], provided such a program is considered by the Board to be equal to that required in this Commonwealth at the time such program was completed and who meets the requirements of character and preliminary education.
