- 8 Section 1. Section 2(5) of the act of August 15, 1961
- 9 (P.L.987, No.442), known as the Pennsylvania Prevailing Wage
- 10 Act, is amended to read:
- 11 Section 2. Definitions.--As used in this act--
- 12 * * *
- 13 (5) "Public work" means construction, reconstruction,
- 14 demolition, alteration and/or repair work other than maintenance
- 15 work, done under contract and paid for in whole or in part out
- 16 of the funds of a public body where the estimated cost of the
- 17 total project is in excess of twenty-five thousand dollars
- 18 (\$25,000), but shall not include work performed under a
- 19 rehabilitation or manpower training program. The term shall not

- 1 <u>include work on historic property as defined under 37 Pa.C.S. §</u>
- 2 103 (relating to definitions), property maintained by a
- 3 qualified historical and archeological society that satisfies
- 4 the criteria under 37 Pa.C.S. § 307 (relating to qualified
- 5 <u>historical and archeological societies</u>), property maintained by
- 6 <u>a historic preservation organization or property maintained by a</u>
- 7 land trust that operates under the act of July 2, 1993 (P.L.359,
- 8 No.50), known as the "Keystone Recreation, Park and Conservation
- 9 Fund Act."
