AN ACT

- Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain 2 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial 3 schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," in organization meetings and officers of boards of school directors, providing for executive 6 sessions. 8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 10 Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known 11 as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a 12 section to read: Section 425. Executive Sessions. -- (a) Notwithstanding 65 13 14 Pa.C.S. § 708(a) (relating to executive sessions), a public school entity may hold an executive session to plan, review or 15 16 discuss matters related to school safety, the disclosure of 17 which, if conducted in public, would:
- (2) create a reasonable likelihood of jeopardizing the 20

measures; or

(1) be reasonably likely to impair the effectiveness of such

- 1 safety or security of an individual or a school, including a
- 2 building, public utility, resource, infrastructure, facility or
- 3 information storage system.
- 4 (b) The executive session may be held during an open meeting
- 5 or at the conclusion of an open meeting or may be announced for
- 6 <u>a future time. The reason for holding the executive session must</u>
- 7 <u>be announced at the open meeting occurring immediately prior or</u>
- 8 <u>subsequent to the executive session</u>. If the executive session is
- 9 not announced for a specific time in the future, members of the
- 10 agency shall be notified twenty-four (24) hours in advance of
- 11 the time of the convening of the meeting specifying the date,
- 12 time, location and purpose of the executive session.
- (c) Official action on discussions held pursuant to
- 14 <u>subsection (a) shall be taken at an open meeting. Nothing in</u>
- 15 this section shall be construed to require that any meeting be
- 16 closed to the public, nor shall any executive session be used as
- 17 a subterfuge to defeat the purposes of 65 Pa.C.S. § 704
- 18 (relating to open meetings).
- 19 (d) For the purposes of this section, the term "executive
- 20 session" shall have the meaning given to the term under 65
- 21 Pa.C.S. § 703 (relating to definitions).
- 22 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
