AN ACT

1 Designating the bridge on Maple Avenue over the Yellow Breeches
2 Creek in Walnut Bottom Township, Cumberland County (bridge
3 number 21-3009-0012-0000), as the Sergeant Kenneth Lee "Buck"
4 Devor Memorial Bridge.

5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
6 hereby enacts as follows:

7 Section 1. Sergeant Kenneth Lee "Buck" Devor Memorial Bridge.

8 (a) Findings.--The General Assembly finds and declares as
9 follows:

10 (1) Sergeant Kenneth Lee "Buck" Devor, a native of
11 Walnut Bottom, was drafted into the United States Army on
12 December 2, 1966.

13 (2) While serving with Troop C, 3rd Squadron, 4th
14 Cavalry Regiment, 25th Infantry Division (Tropic Lightning
15 Division), during the Tet Offensive, Sergeant Devor was
16 killed in action on February 10, 1968.

17 (3) Sergeant Devor was awarded the Bronze Star Medal for
18 Meritorious Service, the Bronze Star with 'V' for Valor, the
19 Purple Heart, the Combat Infantryman's Badge and the Republic

1 of Vietnam Military Merit Medal.

2 (b) Designation.--The section of Maple Avenue over the
3 Yellow Breeches Creek in Walnut Bottom Township, Cumberland
4 County (bridge number 21-3009-0012-0000), is designated the
5 Sergeant Kenneth Lee "Buck" Devor Memorial Bridge.

6 (c) Signs.--The Department of Transportation shall erect and
7 maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the bridge to
8 traffic in both directions on the bridge.

9 Section 2. Effective date.

10 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
