## AN ACT

- Amending Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in sentencing, providing 2 for sentencing for offenses involving domestic violence in 3 the presence of a minor. 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 7 Section 1. Title 42 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a section to read: § 9720.8. Sentencing for offenses involving domestic violence 9 10 in the presence of a minor. 11 (a) Sentencing enhancement. -- The Pennsylvania Commission on 12 Sentencing, in accordance with section 2154 (relating to adoption of guidelines for sentencing), shall provide for a 13 sentence enhancement within its quidelines for an offense under 14
- 15 <u>18 Pa.C.S. § 2701 (relating to simple assault) or 2702 (relating</u>
- 16 to aggravated assault), specifying variations from the range of
- 17 <u>sentences applicable based on such aggravating circumstances as</u>
- 18 the assault was committed against a family or household member

- 1 and the defendant knew the crime was witnessed, either through
- 2 <u>sight or sound, by a minor who is also a family or household</u>
- 3 member of the defendant or the victim.
- 4 (b) Definitions.--As used in this section, the following
- 5 words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this
- 6 <u>subsection unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:</u>
- 7 <u>"Family or household member." The term shall have the same</u>
- 8 meaning as "family or household members" under 23 Pa.C.S. § 6102
- 9 <u>(relating to definitions).</u>
- 10 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
