## AN ACT

Amending the act of July 23, 1970 (P.L.563, No.195), entitled "An act establishing rights in public employes to organize 2 and bargain collectively through selected representatives; 3 defining public employes to include employes of nonprofit organizations and institutions; providing compulsory 5 mediation and fact-finding, for collective bargaining 6 impasses; providing arbitration for certain public employes for collective bargaining impasses; defining the scope of 7 8 collective bargaining; establishing unfair employe and 9 10 employer practices; prohibiting strikes for certain public employes; permitting strikes under limited conditions; 11 providing penalties for violations; and establishing 12 procedures for implementation," in definitions, further 13 providing for definitions; and, in employee rights, providing 14 for notice of right to resign membership. 15 16 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 17 hereby enacts as follows: 18 Section 1. Section 301(18) of the act of July 23, 1970 (P.L.563, No.195), known as the Public Employe Relations Act, is 19 20 amended to read: 21 Section 301. As used in this act: 22 23 "Maintenance of membership" means that all employes who 24 have joined an employe organization or who join the employe

- 1 organization in the future must remain members for the duration
- 2 of a collective bargaining agreement so providing with the
- 3 proviso that any such employe or employes may resign from such
- 4 employe organization during a period of [fifteen] <u>forty-five</u>
- 5 days prior to the expiration of any such agreement.

- 7 Section 2. The act is amended by adding a section to read:
- 8 <u>Section 402. (a) A public employer shall notify, in</u>
- 9 writing, all public employes in a collective bargaining unit of
- 10 their right to resign their membership in an employe
- 11 organization during a period of forty-five days prior to the
- 12 <u>expiration of their collective bargaining agreement. Notice</u>
- 13 <u>under this subsection shall be provided in January of each year.</u>
- 14 (b) An employe organization representing members of a
- 15 collective bargaining unit shall notify, in writing, the members
- 16 of their right to resign their membership from the employe
- 17 organization within a period of ten business days before the
- 18 forty-five day period prior to the expiration of their
- 19 collective bargaining agreement.
- 20 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 30 days.
