4	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5	hereby enacts as follows:
6	Section 1. Title 42 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
7	Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
8	§ 8316.2. Nondisclosure agreements.
9	(a) NoticeA settlement agreement containing a provision
10	that prevents the disclosure of the underlying facts and
11	circumstances to the action subject to the settlement agreement,
12	which is entered into on or after the effective date of this
13	section, shall contain a provision stating that nothing in the
14	agreement prevents the reporting of the underlying facts and
15	circumstances to the action to a law enforcement official.
16	(b) Agreement voidA provision in a settlement agreement
17	that prevents the disclosure of the underlying facts and
18	circumstances to the action subject to the settlement agreement,

1	whether entered into prior to, on or after the effective date of
2	this section, shall not prevent the reporting of the underlying
3	facts and circumstances to the action to a law enforcement
4	official, nor be used to impair or attempt to impair the ability
5	of any person to discuss the underlying facts and circumstances
6	with a law enforcement official, regardless of who initiated the
7	contact. A provision in a settlement agreement contrary to this
8	subsection shall be void and unenforceable.
9	(c) FormThe notice described in subsection (a) shall be
10	printed in boldface, 12-point font or larger, as follows or in a
11	substantially similar form:
12	NOTICE TO ALL PARTIES
13	By signing this agreement, you do not surrender your right to
14	speak to law enforcement about the actions, underlying facts or
15	circumstances referenced in this agreement.
16	I (we) acknowledge receipt of the above notice.

18	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
