- 1 This chapter relates to demographic impact statements.
- 2 § 2102. Definitions.
- 3 The following words and phrases when used in this chapter
- 4 shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 5 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 6 "Commission." The Pennsylvania Commission on Sentencing
- 7 <u>established under 42 Pa.C.S. § 2151.2 (relating to commission).</u>
- 8 <u>§ 2103. Demographic impact statements.</u>
- 9 (a) Authorized. -- Upon request of a member of either house of
- 10 the General Assembly, the commission shall complete a
- 11 <u>demographic impact statement for any bill or amendment to a bill</u>
- 12 proposing a change to 42 Pa.C.S. Ch. 97 (relating to sentencing)
- 13 or 18 Pa.C.S. (relating to crimes and offenses) to determine the
- 14 impact, if any, the proposed bill or amendment may have on the
- 15 demographic composition of the criminal offender population or
- 16 juvenile court system. The demographic impact statement shall be
- 17 impartial, simple and understandable.
- 18 (b) Bill.--Except as otherwise provided in subsection (e)
- 19 (1), no bill for which a demographic impact statement has been
- 20 requested under subsection (a) may be given second consideration
- 21 by the house of the General Assembly whose member made the
- 22 request until such time as the commission has attached the
- 23 demographic impact statement.
- 24 (c) Amendment. -- Except as otherwise provided in subsection
- 25 (e)(2), neither an amendment for which a demographic impact
- 26 statement has been requested under subsection (a), nor the bill
- 27 to which the amendment is offered, shall be considered by the
- 28 house of the General Assembly whose member made the request
- 29 until such time as the commission has attached the demographic
- 30 impact statement.

- 1 (d) Contents. -- For groups for which data are available
- 2 regarding racial and ethnic composition, geographic and
- 3 <u>socioeconomic status, age, gender and religious and</u>
- 4 <u>ethnoreligious affiliations</u>, the demographic impact statement
- 5 <u>shall include the following:</u>
- 6 (1) An estimate of how the legislation would change the
- 7 <u>demographic composition of the criminal offender population</u>
- 8 <u>and juvenile court system.</u>
- 9 (2) A statement of the methodologies and assumptions
- 10 <u>used in preparing the estimate.</u>
- 11 (3) If the demographic impact statement addresses the
- 12 <u>effect of the legislation on the criminal offender population</u>
- and juvenile court system, an estimate of the demographic
- 14 <u>composition of the crime victims who may be affected by the</u>
- 15 <u>legislation</u>.
- (e) Failure to attach. -- The following shall apply:
- 17 (1) If the commission fails to attach a demographic
- impact statement to a bill within 10 days after a request for
- a statement has been submitted to the commission, the bill
- 20 may be further considered in the same manner as if the
- 21 demographic impact statement is attached to the bill.
- 22 (2) If the commission fails to attach a demographic
- 23 <u>impact statement to an amendment within 10 days after a</u>
- reguest for a statement has been submitted to the commission,
- 25 the bill and the amendment may be considered in the same
- 26 manner as if the demographic impact statement is attached to
- the amendment.
- 28 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
