- Recognizing the week of April 16 through 22, 2017, as "National Healthcare Decisions Week" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, Advance directives help individuals indicate the
- 4 kind of care they want during a medical crisis or at the end of
- 5 their life; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Advance directives support individuals and families
- 7 in receiving humane, personalized health care by respecting an
- 8 individual's wishes and values; and
- 9 WHEREAS, The use of advance directives often leads to reduced
- 10 health care costs by avoiding unwanted and unnecessary health
- 11 care expenses; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Advance directive forms are free, legal, readily
- 13 available and straightforward; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Advance directive forms can be obtained online and
- 15 from State health care facilities and faith-based institutions;

- 1 WHEREAS, Only a small percentage of Pennsylvanians have an
- 2 advance directive; and
- 3 WHEREAS, The rate of use of advance directives is lower among
- 4 those in minority groups and is now recognized as a minority
- 5 health disparity; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Educational and public information programs can
- 7 increase the rate of use of advance directives; therefore be it
- 8 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize the
- 9 week of April 16 through 22, 2017, as "National Healthcare
- 10 Decisions Week" in Pennsylvania.
