## A RESOLUTION

- Designating the week of May 6 through 12, 2017, as "Nurses Week" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, "National Nurses Week" begins May 6 and ends May 12
- 4 each year, in conjunction with Florence Nightingale's birthday;
- 5 and
- 6 WHEREAS, This Commonwealth has 217,000 registered nurses,
- 7 including approximately 51,000 licensed practical nurses and
- 8 15,500 advanced practice registered nurses, which makes nursing
- 9 the largest licensed health care profession in this
- 10 Commonwealth; and
- 11 WHEREAS, The Pennsylvania State Nurses Association is the
- 12 Statewide association representing the interests of professional
- 13 registered nurses; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Established in 1903, the Pennsylvania State Nurses

- 1 Association has been essential in advocating, leading, educating
- 2 and connecting nurses to improve health for patients for more
- 3 than 114 years; and
- 4 WHEREAS, The Pennsylvania State Nurses Association is working
- 5 diligently to create a healthier Commonwealth by relying on
- 6 increasing the delivery of nursing care through primary and
- 7 preventive health care; and
- 8 WHEREAS, The care provided by nurses in this Commonwealth is
- 9 the primary component to a successful health care delivery
- 10 system; therefore be it
- 11 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate the
- 12 week of May 6 through 12, 2017, as "Nurses Week" in
- 13 Pennsylvania; and be it further
