A RESOLUTION

1 2	Designating June 12, 2017, as "Behavior Analyst Appreciation Day" in Pennsylvania.
3	WHEREAS, A behavior analyst is a mental health professional
4	who, in the United States, holds a master's degree or higher in
5	behavior analysis, psychology or education; and
6	WHEREAS, Behavior analysts must hold master's-level Board
7	Certified Behavior Analyst certification or meet similar
8	education standards; and
9	WHEREAS, Behavior analysis is a science, distinct from
10	psychology, in which processes are systematically applied to
11	improve socially significant behavior to a meaningful degree;
12	and
13	WHEREAS, The practice of applied behavior analysis ranges
14	from treatment of individuals with autism and developmental
15	disabilities to behavioral coaching and behavioral
16	psychotherapy; and

1 WHEREAS, Behavior analysts constantly assess methods to 2 modify behaviors and experiment with new techniques in a 3 constantly evolving field; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Ole Ivar Lovaas, a Norwegian American who earned
a doctorate in clinical psychology from the University of
Washington in 1958, has investigated various therapy techniques
rooted in behavior analysis in the treatment of autistic
children; and

9 WHEREAS, Dr. Lovaas' work has transformed the treatment of 10 autistic individuals, incontrovertibly establishing the practice 11 of applied behavior analysis as a scientifically validated 12 therapy for a variety of behavioral disorders; and 13 WHEREAS, The American Academy of Pediatrics and the United 14 States Surgeon General have endorsed the use of behavior 15 analysis in the treatment of autism; and

16 WHEREAS, Behavior analysis is widely recognized as the most 17 effective treatment for children with autism spectrum disorder 18 and the only treatment shown to lead to significant, lasting 19 improvements in the lives of individuals with autism; and 20 WHEREAS, Behavior analysts primarily work one-on-one with 21 individuals with autism and may have a high caseload with 22 multiple patient appointments each day; and

23 WHEREAS, Some behavior analysts take on supervisory roles, 24 advising other health care providers or caregivers on behavior 25 intervention plans or overseeing assistant behavior analysts and 26 registered behavior technicians who are working directly with 27 patients; and

28 WHEREAS, "Behavior Analyst Appreciation Day" is an 29 opportunity to recognize the important work and professional 30 commitment of behavior analysts; therefore be it
