A RESOLUTION

- Designating the month of September 2017 as "Emergency
- 2 Preparedness Month" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, Each year, the President of the United States
- 4 proclaims September as "National Emergency Preparedness Month"
- 5 to stress the importance of strengthening the security and
- 6 resiliency of the nation through systematic preparation for the
- 7 full range of hazards threatening the United States, including
- 8 natural disasters, cyber attacks, pandemic disease and acts of
- 9 terrorism; and
- 10 WHEREAS, During "Emergency Preparedness Month," residents and
- 11 the townships, boroughs, cities and counties in which they live
- 12 are encouraged to take time to ensure they are prepared for any
- 13 disaster, natural or manmade; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Each year, in communities large and small, victims

- 1 of disasters and emergencies in this Commonwealth and across the
- 2 United States turn to neighbors, familiar and new, for help
- 3 through emergency services including: the American Red Cross,
- 4 the Salvation Army, local fire departments, police departments,
- 5 ambulance and paramedic services, military bases, hospitals,
- 6 urban search and rescue units, wilderness search and rescue
- 7 groups, canine rescue units, dive teams, county 911 coordinators
- 8 and staff, county hazardous materials teams, local emergency
- 9 management coordinators and staff, county emergency management
- 10 coordinators and staff, medevac agencies, the Pennsylvania State
- 11 Police, Civil Air Patrols, ham radio operators, National Guard
- 12 personnel, local fire police and many other paid staff and
- 13 volunteers with various governmental and nonprofit agencies and
- 14 other groups; and
- 15 WHEREAS, The Federal Emergency Management Agency and the
- 16 Pennsylvania Emergency Management Agency encourage individuals
- 17 to have emergency preparedness kits on hand should disaster
- 18 strike and provide information through their websites,
- 19 www.ready.gov and www.readypa.org, to educate residents on how
- 20 to prepare for emergencies and disasters; and
- 21 WHEREAS, Designating the month of September 2017 as
- 22 "Emergency Preparedness Month" can help empower Commonwealth
- 23 residents by providing information about the risks all residents
- 24 can face and the concrete actions they can take to protect
- 25 themselves, their families, their communities, this Commonwealth
- 26 and our country; therefore be it
- 27 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate the
- 28 month of September 2017 as "Emergency Preparedness Month" in
- 29 Pennsylvania and extend its thanks to the staff and volunteers
- 30 who serve this Commonwealth and our nation through emergency

- 2 and all emergencies and disasters, natural or manmade; and be it
