## A RESOLUTION

- Recognizing the week of September 24 through 30, 2017, as "National Adult Education and Family Literacy Week" in Pennsylvania.
- 4 WHEREAS, The literacy of the residents of Pennsylvania is
- 5 essential for their economic well-being and for the prosperity
- 6 of this Commonwealth; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Without literacy skills, an individual's ability to
- 8 complete high school or an equivalency program, continue onto a
- 9 postsecondary degree or complete a job training program is
- 10 negatively impacted; and
- 11 WHEREAS, A lack of literacy skills increases an individual's
- 12 chances of encountering unemployment or underemployment, which
- 13 may impede the individual's ability to provide for his or her
- 14 family; and
- 15 WHEREAS, Literacy among adults is key to ensuring the
- 16 educational success of future generations, with research showing

- 1 that reading to children by adults has a direct impact on
- 2 children's academic achievement; and
- 3 WHEREAS, According to the National Center for Education
- 4 Statistics, approximately 13% of adults in Pennsylvania lack the
- 5 basic reading and math skills to read and follow medical
- 6 instructions, placing the health of affected individuals and
- 7 their families at risk; and
- 8 WHEREAS, "National Adult Education and Family Literacy Week"
- 9 highlights the need for the nation to support efforts to ensure
- 10 that everyone has the necessary literacy skills to succeed at
- 11 home, at work and in society; and
- 12 WHEREAS, "National Adult Education and Family Literacy Week"
- 13 is being celebrated from September 24 through 30, 2017;
- 14 therefore be it
- 15 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize the
- 16 week of September 24 through 30, 2017, as "National Adult
- 17 Education and Family Literacy Week" in Pennsylvania.
