A RESOLUTION

- Designating December 16, 2017, as "Wreaths Across America Day" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, The Wreaths Across America project began in 1992
- 4 with the transportation and placement of 5,000 Maine balsam fir
- 5 remembrance wreaths on the graves of the fallen heroes buried at
- 6 Arlington National Cemetery; and
- 7 WHEREAS, The Wreaths Across America project is recognized
- 8 annually in December; and
- 9 WHEREAS, More than 3,317,000 wreaths have been sent to
- 10 locations, including national cemeteries and veterans memorials,
- 11 in every state and overseas; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Each December hundreds of thousands of individuals
- 13 volunteer to help lay remembrance wreaths; and
- 14 WHEREAS, In 2016, more than 1,200,000 wreaths were placed at
- 15 1,226 locations nationwide; and

- 1 WHEREAS, The mission of the Wreaths Across America project,
- 2 to "Remember, Honor and Teach," is carried out in part by
- 3 coordinating wreath-laying ceremonies in all 50 states, at sea
- 4 and abroad, including at Arlington National Cemetery, veterans
- 5 cemeteries and other locations; and
- 6 WHEREAS, The Wreaths Across America project includes a
- 7 weeklong veterans parade between Maine and Virginia to spread a
- 8 message about the importance of remembering the fallen heroes of
- 9 the United States, honoring those who serve and reminding
- 10 citizens of the sacrifices made by veterans and their families
- 11 to preserve freedoms in the United States; and
- 12 WHEREAS, The tradition of escorting tractor trailers filled
- 13 with donated wreaths from Harrington, Maine, to Arlington
- 14 National Cemetery will be continued by the Patriot Guard Riders
- 15 and other patriotic escort units, including motorcycle units,
- 16 law enforcement units and first responder units; and
- 17 WHEREAS, The trucking industry in the United States continues
- 18 to support the Wreaths Across America project by providing
- 19 drivers, equipment and related services to assist in the
- 20 transportation of wreaths across the United States to more than
- 21 1,000 locations; and
- 22 WHEREAS, The 2017 Wreaths Across America theme is "I'm An
- 23 American. Yes I am!"; and
- 24 WHEREAS, On December 11, 2017, this Commonwealth is holding a
- 25 Wreaths Across America ceremony in the Capitol Rotunda;
- 26 therefore be it
- 27 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate
- 28 December 16, 2017, as "Wreaths Across America Day" in
- 29 Pennsylvania and call upon all residents to remember the service
- 30 of veterans and members of the Armed Forces of the United States

- 2 and their families have made, and continue to make, for this
- 3 great nation.
