A RESOLUTION

1 Honoring the 107th anniversary of President Ronald Wilson
2 Reagan's birth on February 6, 2018.

3 WHEREAS, February 6, 2018, will be the 107th anniversary of
4 Ronald Wilson Reagan's birth, 14 years after his death at 93
5 years of age on June 5, 2004; and

6 WHEREAS, Ronald Wilson Reagan was sworn in as the 40th
7 President of the United States on January 20, 1981; and

8 WHEREAS, President Reagan led a remarkably productive life,
9 including military service before and during World War II, work
10 as a stage and movie actor, union leader and television and
11 event spokesman, and public service as a popular two-term
12 Governor of California; and

13 WHEREAS, President Reagan is considered one of the most
14 influential presidents of the 20th century; and

1 WHEREAS, President Reagan is remembered for his great
2 connection to Americans, for restoring confidence and optimism
3 in the American people and for his highly successful diplomatic
4 efforts to end the Cold War; and

5 WHEREAS, During President Reagan's presidency, he worked in a
6 bipartisan manner to enact his agenda of restoring
7 accountability and common sense to government which led to an
8 economic expansion and opportunity for millions of Americans;
9 and

10 WHEREAS, President Reagan's commitment to our armed forces
11 contributed to the restoration of pride in America and its
12 values cherished by the free world and prepared the United
13 States Armed Forces to meet the challenges of the 21st century;

15 WHEREAS, Through his grace, charm, wit and indomitable
16 optimism, President Reagan conveyed the strength of character
17 and greatness of America; therefore be it
