- 10 WHEREAS, AIA Pennsylvania has a Statewide membership of more
- 11 than 2,700; and
- 12 WHEREAS, AIA Pennsylvania and its members advocate good
- 13 community design and responsible stewardship of the built
- 14 environment; and
- 15 WHEREAS, AIA Pennsylvania and its members maintain the
