## A RESOLUTION

- Recognizing the week of March 5 through 9, 2018, as "National School Breakfast Week" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, "National School Breakfast Week" is observed
- 4 annually to increase student participation in the child
- 5 nutrition initiative known as the School Breakfast Program; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Administered federally by the Food and Nutrition
- 7 Service of the United States Department of Agriculture, the
- 8 School Breakfast Program provides healthy breakfast options in
- 9 age-appropriate serving sizes to more than 8.5 million
- 10 qualifying children each school day; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Any public school, intermediate unit, charter
- 12 school, area vocational-technical school or career technology
- 13 school, public residential child-care institution, tax-exempt
- 14 nonpublic school or residential child-care institution may apply
- 15 to be a School Breakfast Program sponsor; and
- 16 WHEREAS, The Division of Food and Nutrition of the

- 1 Pennsylvania Department of Education, recognizing the value of
- 2 adequate and proper nutrition for each child, administers the
- 3 School Breakfast Program in this Commonwealth; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Local school food authorities operate the School
- 5 Breakfast Program in Commonwealth schools for the benefit of
- 6 more than 200,000 participating students; and
- 7 WHEREAS, The House of Representatives acknowledges the
- 8 importance of childhood nutrition and the correlation between
- 9 existing school breakfast plans and children's focus on
- 10 learning; and
- 11 WHEREAS, The House of Representatives notes that schools in
- 12 this Commonwealth prepare and serve healthy food options in
- 13 keeping with applicable recommendations of the Dietary
- 14 Guidelines for Americans; and
- 15 WHEREAS, The School Nutrition Association has suggested that
- 16 school officials decorate the cafeteria, invite special quests,
- 17 offer special menu items and conduct games, activities and
- 18 contests in conjunction with "National School Breakfast Week"
- 19 observances; and
- 20 WHEREAS, Related activity sheets for use in schools are
- 21 available at the School Nutrition Association's publicly
- 22 accessible Internet website; therefore be it
