3	WHEREAS, "National Train Day" was first established in 2008
4	to educate the public about the rich history of our nation's
5	trains as well as the advantages of rail travel; and
6	WHEREAS, This observation is held annually on the Saturday
7	closest to May 10, the day that the nation's first
8	transcontinental railway was completed in 1869 in Promontory,
9	Utah; and
10	WHEREAS, Since 1869, the development of rail travel has
11	revolutionized Pennsylvania, transforming this great
12	Commonwealth into an industrial powerhouse in the region and the
13	nation; and
14	WHEREAS, Rail travel is an essential part of our

1 transportation infrastructure, helping to reduce congestion on 2 the roads and in the skies, connecting cities and rural 3 communities and providing a more environmentally friendly mode 4 of transportation that contributes to our energy security; 5 therefore be it

6 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize May 12, 7 2018, as "National Train Day" in Pennsylvania and encourage 8 residents of this Commonwealth to learn more about the history 9 of trains as well as their positive impact on this Commonwealth 10 and our nation; and be it further
