A RESOLUTION

1 Designating the week of April 30 through May 7, 2018, as
2 "Children's Mental Health Awareness Week" in Pennsylvania.

3 WHEREAS, Addressing the complex mental health needs of
4 children, youths and families is fundamental to the future of
5 our Commonwealth; and

6 WHEREAS, Developing comprehensive, coordinated mental health
7 services for children, youths and families is a critical
8 responsibility of State government; and

9 WHEREAS, It is appropriate that we set aside one week each
10 year to direct our attention to our children's mental health and
11 well-being and our system of related resources and services;
12 therefore be it

13 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate the
14 week of April 30 through May 7, 2018, as "Children's Mental
15 Health Awareness Week" in Pennsylvania; and be it further

16 RESOLVED, That all residents, agencies and organizations

1 interested in meeting every child's mental health needs unite in
2 this observance and in addressing the fundamental necessity of a
3 comprehensive year-round mental health program for children,
4 youths and families.
