A RESOLUTION

1 Designating the month of October 2018 as "Pennsylvania
2 Pharmacists and Pharmacy Month" in Pennsylvania.

3 WHEREAS, Pharmacists and pharmacies are responsible for
4 substantial contributions to health care in all practice
5 settings in this Commonwealth and across the nation; and

6 WHEREAS, As of September 2018, this Commonwealth has 17,665
7 licensed pharmacists working toward improving medication use by
8 reducing abuse and advancing patient care in all practice
9 settings; and

10 WHEREAS, Since its founding in 1878, the Pennsylvania
11 Pharmacists Association has served as a leading voice of
12 pharmacy by promoting the profession through advocacy, education
13 and communication in an effort to enhance patient care and
14 public health; and

1 WHEREAS, The Pennsylvania Pharmacists Association is a
2 vibrant part of the pharmacy community in Pennsylvania and has a
3 diverse membership comprised of pharmacists, students,
4 technicians, part-time employees and retirees from a variety of
5 practice settings all working together to deliver the best
6 possible care for patients across this Commonwealth; and

7 WHEREAS, "Pennsylvania Pharmacists and Pharmacy Month" is a
8 time to thank our pharmacists for the work they do and promote
9 medicinal education to the public, especially in a time when
10 health care and prescription drug abuse are major issues facing
11 this Commonwealth and the nation; therefore be it

12 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate the
13 month of October 2018 as "Pennsylvania Pharmacists and Pharmacy
14 Month" in Pennsylvania; and be it further

15 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives encourage all
16 residents of this Commonwealth to observe "Pennsylvania
17 Pharmacists and Pharmacy Month" and to recognize and thank
18 pharmacists for their contributions.
