A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing the week of November 12 through 16, 2018, as  
2 "American Education Week" in Pennsylvania.

3 WHEREAS, National attention must be focused on the integral  
4 role that education plays in preparing citizens of the United  
5 States for the future in an increasingly competitive and  
6 interdependent world; and

7 WHEREAS, A well-educated work force is vital to the economic  
8 well-being of the United States and of this Commonwealth; and

9 WHEREAS, A good education leads to more skilled and higher  
10 paying jobs; and

11 WHEREAS, "American Education Week" offers all Americans a  
12 wonderful opportunity to celebrate public education and honor  
13 individuals who are making a difference in ensuring that every  
14 child receives a quality education through their 2018 theme,

1 "Public schools: We are here for all"; and

2 WHEREAS, This Commonwealth has a strong and historic  
3 tradition of commitment to public education and has been blessed  
4 with the leadership of brilliant and innovative educators;  
5 therefore be it

6 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize the  
7 week of November 12 through 16, 2018, as "American Education  
8 Week" in Pennsylvania; and be it further

9 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives urge educators,  
10 parents and students throughout this Commonwealth to observe  
11 "American Education Week" in Pennsylvania and use it to nurture  
12 the educational opportunities in this Commonwealth; and be it

14 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives urge employers in  
15 this Commonwealth to encourage employees who are parents to  
16 visit their child's school and get more involved in efforts to  
17 promote and enhance learning.
