## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Designating November 2, 2018, as "Veterans, Record Your
- Discharge Day" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, A military release or discharge document is one of
- 4 the most important documents a veteran will receive after the
- 5 veteran's service to this great country; and
- 6 WHEREAS, This Commonwealth has 67 counties, all of which have
- 7 a recorder of deeds office or its equivalent; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Original military release or discharge documents are
- 9 recorded in each county office daily for the protection,
- 10 preservation and reproduction of each release or discharge
- 11 document; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Each release or discharge document serves as a
- 13 permanent record and a reminder of the valuable service our
- 14 veterans have given to this country; and
- 15 WHEREAS, A veteran is oftentimes required to provide
- 16 certified copies of the veteran's release or discharge documents

- 1 to obtain various Federal or State benefits, for use in the
- 2 execution of wills and estate purposes, as well as certain
- 3 employment purposes; and
- 4 WHEREAS, The recording of these documents will help preserve
- 5 a veteran's release or discharge history and will further
- 6 provide for copies in case of loss or damage to an original
- 7 release or discharge document; and
- 8 WHEREAS, The use of the recorder of deeds offices is
- 9 beneficial to a veteran and the veteran's family because the
- 10 service is free, the office assists in the protection against
- 11 identity theft and ensures that the veteran's release or
- 12 discharge documents can be retrieved at a later date quickly and
- 13 conveniently; therefore be it
- 14 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives encourage all
- 15 veterans and their families to record veterans' release or
- 16 discharge documents with their respective county recorder of
- 17 deeds office; and be it further
- 18 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate
- 19 November 2, 2018, as "Veterans, Record Your Discharge Day" in
- 20 Pennsylvania.
