1 2 3 4 5 6 7 8	Amending the act of January 25, 1966 (1965 P.L.1546, No.541), entitled "An act providing scholarships and providing funds to secure Federal funds for qualified students of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania who need financial assistance to attend postsecondary institutions of higher learning, making an appropriation, and providing for the administration of this act," further providing for eligibility for State scholarship.
9	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
10	hereby enacts as follows:
11	Section 1. Section 4(a)(6) of the act of January 25, 1966
12	(1965 P.L.1546, No.541), referred to as the Higher Education
13	Scholarship Law, is amended to read:
14	Section 4. (a) Any student is eligible for consideration
15	for a State scholarship providing:
16	* * *
17	(6) The State scholarship recipient shall be free to attend
18	any approved institution of his choice and apply the scholarship
19	toward the tuition, room, board, books and fees of that
20	institution[.], subject to the following:

1 <u>(i)</u> The institution is not required to accept the 2 scholarship recipient for enrollment, but is free to exact 3 compliance with its own admission requirements, standards and 4 policies.

(ii) If the institution is headquartered and domiciled 5 through incorporation or charter in this Commonwealth, the 6 7 scholarship recipient shall be eliqible for the scholarship 8 award regardless of whether the program of study or the 9 scholarship recipient's term enrollment is 100% online or blended with classroom credits, provided that the scholarship 10 recipient meets all other eligibility requirements as provided 11 12 in this act and as established by the agency. 13 (iii) If the institution has a physical location in this 14 Commonwealth but is not headquartered and domiciled through incorporation or charter in this Commonwealth, the scholarship 15 16 recipient shall be eligible for a scholarship award provided 17 that the scholarship recipient's program of study is not 18 structured to be more than 50% online or the scholarship 19 recipient's online enrollment in a given term does not exceed 20 50% of the total credits for that term as established by the 21 agency, provided that the scholarship recipient is enrolled at 22 the institution's physical location in this Commonwealth and 23 provided that the scholarship recipient meets all other 24 eligibility requirements as provided in this act and as established by the agency. 25 * * * 26 27 Section 2. The amendment of section 4(a)(6) of the act shall apply not later than the 2018-2019 award year as determined by 28

29 the Pennsylvania Higher Education Assistance Agency.

30 Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
