AN ACT

Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in assault, further providing for the offense of aggravated assault. 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 5 hereby enacts as follows: 6 Section 1. Section 2702(a)(2), (b) and (c) of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended to read: 8 § 2702. Aggravated assault. 9 Offense defined. -- A person is quilty of aggravated 10 assault if he: 11 attempts to cause or intentionally, knowingly or 12 13 recklessly causes serious bodily injury to any of the officers, agents, employees or other persons enumerated in 14 15 subsection (c) [or to an employee of an agency, company or 16 other entity engaged in public transportation], while in the 17 performance of duty;

- 1 (b) Grading. -- Aggravated assault under subsection (a) (1),
- 2 (2) [and] or (9) is a felony of the first degree. Aggravated
- 3 assault under subsection (a) (3), (4), (5), (6), (7) [and] $\underline{\text{or}}$ (8)
- 4 is a felony of the second degree.
- 5 (c) Officers, employees, etc., enumerated.--The officers,
- 6 agents, employees and other persons referred to in subsection
- 7 (a) shall be as follows:

- 22 (10) Judge of any court in the unified judicial system.
- 23 (11) The Attorney General.
- 24 (12) A deputy attorney general.
- 25 (13) A district attorney.
- 26 (14) An assistant district attorney.
- 27 (15) A public defender.
- 28 (16) An assistant public defender.
- 29 (17) A Federal law enforcement official.
- 30 (18) A State law enforcement official.

- 1 (19) A local law enforcement official.
- 2 (20) Any person employed to assist or who assists any
- Federal, State or local law enforcement official.
- 4 (21) Emergency medical services personnel.
- 5 (22) Parking enforcement officer.
- 6 (23) A magisterial district judge.

- 12 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
