- 9 Section 1. Section 696(n) of the act of March 10, 1949
- (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, is 10
- 11 amended to read:
- 12 Section 696. Distress in School Districts of the First
- Class.--* * * 13
- 14 The [Secretary of Education, only upon the
- 15 recommendation of a majority of the School Reform Commission]
- 16 Governor, after proper investigation of the district's financial
- 17 condition, the administrative practices of the School Reform
- 18 Commission and other matters deemed appropriate by the Secretary
- 19 of Education, may issue a declaration to dissolve the School
- Reform Commission if the Governor determines that dissolving the 20

- 1 <u>School Reform Commission is in the best interests of the</u>
- 2 students of the school district. The dissolution declaration
- 3 shall be issued at least one hundred eighty (180) days prior to
- 4 the end of the current school year and shall be effective at the
- 5 end of that school year. Except as otherwise provided in this
- 6 section, after dissolution the board of school directors shall
- 7 have the powers and duties of the School Reform Commission.

- 9 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
